PREAMBLE: The Commissioner of Food Safety is required to 'ensure an efficient and uniform implementation of the standards and other requirements as specified and to ensure a high standard of objectivity, accountability, practicability, transparency and credibility', (under sub-section 30(2)(d) of the Food Safety & Standards Act, 2006).

ZONAL ALLOCATION ORDER

Classification of Zonal Assignments are as under:

Category	Nature of Assignment
Zone I	Field Enforcement Duties, Sampling (<i>Enforcement, Legal & Surveillance etc.</i>) Work, Licensing and Registration Functions, Assignments Involving Inspection, Enforcement, Regulatory Decision-Making, Evidence-Collection, Disciplinary Proceedings or Direct Public Interface, confidential informations, Remaining works not allotted to other Zones.
Zone II	Food Safety on Wheels (FSW) operations, VVIP Food Safety Duty, Advance Security Liaison (ASL) Duty and other similar operational assignments as assigned by the Competent Authority.
Zone III	Prosecution Work (<i>including all types of Courts related Legal Works</i>), Laboratory Data Updation, High-End Equipment (HEE), Condemnation-related Matters, Maintenance & Updation of Sampling Data, Microbiology Laboratory matters and Other laboratory/technical/administrative assignments as assigned by the NFA In-charge/Competent Authority.

In pursuance of the Department's policy regarding rotation and classification of assignment into **Zone I, Zone II and Z III**, and in the interest of ensuring transparency, accountability equitable distribution of work and effective implementation of the provisions of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 and **Preventive Vigilance Perception**, the Competent Authority is pleased to make Zonal allocations for the Food Safety Officers and Field Assistants with immediate effect as under:

Monthly Roster Duty of FSOs with FSWs and VVIP duty will continued to be issued by the Notified Food Analyst and Designated Officer (HQ) respectively.

Exception: Zonal allocation will temporarily be suspended only in case of Health Emergency, Disease Outbreak, Large-scale Food Contamination Crisis as and when these are notified by the Health & Family Welfare Department, GNCT of Delhi and period of operation of any such notification only.

General Conditions

1. Any deviation from the Zonal Allocation or diversion/review of the work assigned to a particular Zone shall require the prior approval of the Commissioner (Food Safety) which shall not be delegated. The Commissioner shall record the reasons in writing for such deviation before seeking competent approval. The work & officials assigned to a particular Zone shall not be reviewed, altered or diverted till **31.07.2028**.
2. The above allocation of assignments is made purely in the interest of administration and shall not confer any right or claim for continuation in any particular Zone assignment.
3. This Office Order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain operative for a period of **two (02) years** from the date of issuance or till further orders, whichever is later (*to be reviewed after 31.07.2028 only*).

The order is being issued in the best interest of the Department, exercising powers conferred upon by Section 30 of the Food Safety & Standards Act, 2006, in order to ensure good health of the people of Delhi.
